REFUND POLICY:

- There will be no refunds for scratched tests after the entry closing date, 5/11/2026.
- A refund of class fees will be issued upon receipt of a veterinary certification that the horse cannot compete in the show at this time, or documentation of a major medical issue that prevents the exhibitor from participating. All refunds will be at the discretion of the ORCDA Board.
- Office fees are non-refundable.
- Stall and overnight fees are non-refundable if the horse is on the show grounds.

Rider Division Definitions

- Open: Rider that is 18 years or older, who makes a living or receives income from training, teaching/lessons or clinics.
- Amateur: Nonprofessional rider that is 18 years or older.
- Junior: Juniors are not allowed to handle/ride stallions and must wear a helmet when working with a horse at any time (not just while showing). There are two junior divisions. Rider must declare one.
 - 13 and under (An individual who has not reached his/her 14th birthday as of 1/1/2026).
 - 14-17 (An individual who has not reached his/her 18th birthday as of January 1st of current year)

Honorary High Score Award Definitions

- **Rookie Rider:** Amateur Rider in first year of showing Cowboy Dressage.
- **Veteran Rider:** Any US veteran or anyone wishing to ride in honor of a US veteran is eligible. Award is given to any individual one time per year only.
- **Cancer High Score:** Any cancer survivor, anyone battling cancer, or riding in honor of anyone who has had to face Cancer may enter. This award is given to an individual one time per year only.
- **Silver Rider:** 65+ years old Amateur only.
- **90 Year Award:** Amateur Rider and their horse whose ages add up to 90 or above
- **IALHA High Score Award:** Give to the highest single score of a registered IALHA horse and IALHA member in good standing.
- **Jack Brainard Judge's "Try" Award:** For the most improved rider for the duration of the show. To calculate this award, each judge identifies a horse and rider combination that showed marked improvement with each ride.

High Score Award Calculations: All High Score Awards will be awarded to the highest average scoring rider/horse combination for that award for the show. To be eligible a rider/horse combination must show in a minimum of FOUR (4) classes at the show. Unless otherwise noted, the highest 4 scored tests will be added together and then divided by 4. Reserve High Score (where offered) will be awarded using the same calculation. Ties will be broken by the highest soft feel score. Horsemanship high score will be based on top two horsemanship scores of the show.

- **Class Division High Score:** Awarded to the highest average of 4 scores, regardless of rider status, in that class division. Must show a minimum of 4 classes in the division. **Please Note*: Each horse/rider combination will only be eligible to win one Class Division High Score Award in the following class divisions: W/J, W/J/L, Challenge, Gaited, Vaquero Buckaroo. If a rider/horse combination have highest scores in more than one of these Class Divisions, they will be awarded the High Score Award for the Class Division in which they achieved the highest average.*
- **Rider Division High Score:** Awarded to the highest average of 4 scores, in W/J, W/J/L, Challenge, Gaited, or Vaquero Buckaroo (POG, PUS, Freestyle, Liberty & Horsemanship classes are not eligible).
- **Soft Feel High Score:** Awarded to the highest soft feel score in any rider division (POG, PUS, Freestyle, Liberty, and Horsemanship classes are not eligible). Ties will be broken by the highest-scored test.
- **Overall High Single Score:** Awarded to the high single test score in any rider division (POG, PUS, Freestyle, Liberty, and Horsemanship classes not eligible). Ties will be broken by the highest Soft Feel score.
- **Overall Gathering High Score:** Awarded to the highest average of 4 scores, in W/J, W/J/L, Challenge, Gaited, or Vaquero Buckaroo (POG, PUS, Freestyle, Liberty, and Horsemanship classes are not eligible), regardless of rider division. Must show a minimum of 4 classes.
- **Rookie High Score:** Awarded to the highest scoring test, in W/J, W/J/L, Challenge, Gaited, or Vaquero Buckaroo (POG, PUS, Freestyle, Liberty, and Horsemanship classes are not eligible) by an amateur rider in first year of showing Cowboy Dressage.
- **Honorary High Score Awards:** Awards will be given to those with the highest scoring test, regardless of rider division, who have declared a Veteran, Cancer Survivor, Silver Rider, Novice Rider, or "90 years combined" on the registration form. Please remember these awards can only be won once a year.

Horses are allowed to ride in a maximum of 4 under saddle tests per day and can participate in an additional 4 ground classes per day. Freestyle and horsemanship do not to count as one of the four saddle classes.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS DESIGNED BY COWBOY DRESSAGE WORLD, ALL OF WHICH CAN BE FOUND AT www.cowboydressageworld.com AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE HEREWITH.

Owners, Riders and Trainers are responsible for the knowledge of and compliance with the rules of Cowboy Dressage.

- Entries must be paid in full by entry closing date. Any unpaid entries will not receive a number.
- Entries must be made on the form provided herein, fully completed, with all required signatures, and accompanied by a check or money order in the full amount, payable to "ORCDA". Any unpaid entry shall not be recorded. All entries postmarked after closing date will be considered post entries and post entry charges collected.
- Exhibitors are responsible for their own errors and those of their agents in preparation of entry blanks. A horse will not be given a number unless it is entered in at least one class. All horses brought into the grounds must be registered at the show office.
- Show Office is to be advised before the class of 'scratches' or appropriate changes of horse or rider at least one hour before ride time as a courtesy to other competitors and the show office.
- Management reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without notice prior to or during the show.
- Only assigned cars, trucks and/or trailers will be allowed to park in main barn area, as approved by Show Management. This will be strictly enforced. SHOW MANAGEMENT WILL REQUEST THE MOVING OF RV's OR VEHICLES INAPPROPRIATELY PARKED. Failure to remove vehicle or trailers when requested by show management or Linn County Fair & Expo personnel will result in towing of vehicles at owner's expense.
- Stalls will be assigned by Horse Show Management and will be available on Thursday, May 28th at 4:00 p.m. Exhibitors may identify on their entry forms who they would like to be stabled next to but requests for specific stalls will not be considered. All stalls used by exhibitors must be returned to their original condition prior to leaving the grounds. Exhibitors will be billed for the cost of repairing any damage to any stalls they use. *Any stall used, regardless of reason, shall be subject to the regular stall fee.* Only management may reassign stalls. Reassignment may be necessary if an exhibitor cancels after stall assignments have been made or does not use all stalls assigned. Failure to abide by management's stabling assignments may result in an exhibitor being prohibited from competing.
- Refunds, all or part, are governed as follows: entry fees will be returned only if written notice of cancellation is received by the Show Secretary before close of entry deadline. If a horse or rider is unable to compete at the start of the show, only entry fees will be refunded, with the presentation of horse's veterinary certificate or medical documentation of a major health issue, prior to start of show. ORCDA Board of Directors are the only authorized individuals (collectively) to approve a refund.
- Dogs are allowed on the grounds but must be on leash at all times. NO exceptions, please.
- The arena next to the stalls and the large Calapooia arena may be used on Friday. Please do not ride within the court areas on Saturday morning. There will be space in the arena for warming up before your ride. Turn outs are not allowed anywhere on the show grounds.
- Show Office is to be advised before the class of 'scratches' of horse or rider at least one hour before ride time as a courtesy to other competitors and the show office. Any Change may be done case by case and there is a fee as long as it does not disrupt ride times. No changing of classes at the arena.
- This show encourages feedback from its owners, riders, and trainers. Please feel free to stop by the horse show office and fill out our feedback form to provide us with your experience and offering constructive input for future events.
- Callers: Riders are encouraged to memorize their tests. The use of a caller is not mandatory. ORCDA allows the rider to use a caller of their choice; however, the ultimate responsibility for accurate and correct riding of the test falls upon the rider. If the rider chooses to use a caller, it is the rider's responsibility to arrange for one.
- Age of the Horse: The Cowboy Dressage Horses' age is based on January 1st of that calendar year, regardless of the month foaled. For example - a horse foaled anytime in the year 2010 is considered one-year-old on January 1, 2011 and two years old on January 1, 2012.
- A Note About Gaited Horses: The gaited tests are designed specifically for the gaited horse. Gaited horses are welcome in the non-gaited tests but will be scored a maximum high value of 4.5 if gaiting instead of jogging when requested in the non-gaited test.
- Schooling Horses: Due to liability concerns, horses brought to the show to school are required to register through the office and a release signed. Ring fees apply per horse. Mandatory Office fees apply per horse.

Class Descriptions/Rules:

- This class is meant to allow individuals to showcase their partnership and creativity using Cowboy Dressage POG and other groundwork maneuvers.
- Music may be used or not at the discretion of the competitor.
- Costumes or props may be used if desired
- Classes will be held inside challenge court
- Placings with ribbons 1st-6th.
- Equipment: Rope halter and lead, or flat (leather or nylon) halter and lead (no shanks or chains allowed)
- Class will be scored as follows: Use of CD maneuvers, Creativity, Originality, Harmony and Partnership, and Soft Feel, with emphasis on Soft Feel.

Cowboy Dressage Rail Class:

Class Descriptions:

- A group of riders work along the rail, demonstrating Cowboy Dressage gaits, transitions and soft feel. Rider's partnership with their horse is also judged.
- Classes will be held around court (apron/rail)
- Placings with ribbons 1st-6th.
- Judge may call for: Working Walk, Free Walk, Working Jog, Free Jog, Stop, Back, Turn on Forehand or Haunches, Walk on a Loose Rein, Working Lope (in appropriate classes).

Purpose: To showcase the horse and rider's Cowboy Dressage skillset in a group setting, with emphasis on soft feel, balance, harmony and partnership.

Class will be scored as follows: Rider's seat, balance and effective use of aids; Gait freedom and regularity; Group awareness in transitions; Harmony and Partnership; and Soft Feel, with emphasis on Soft Feel.

Cowboy Dressage Trail Class: Scoring includes obstacles, gaits, & collective scores


